Elements that extend to the edge of the page require a bleed addition. This area is trimmed during further processing.

Open trimbox: 55 x 85 mm

Safety distance: at least 5 mm

Important text and image elements should have a safety distance to the final format and to the cutting or creasing lines due to production tolerances.
